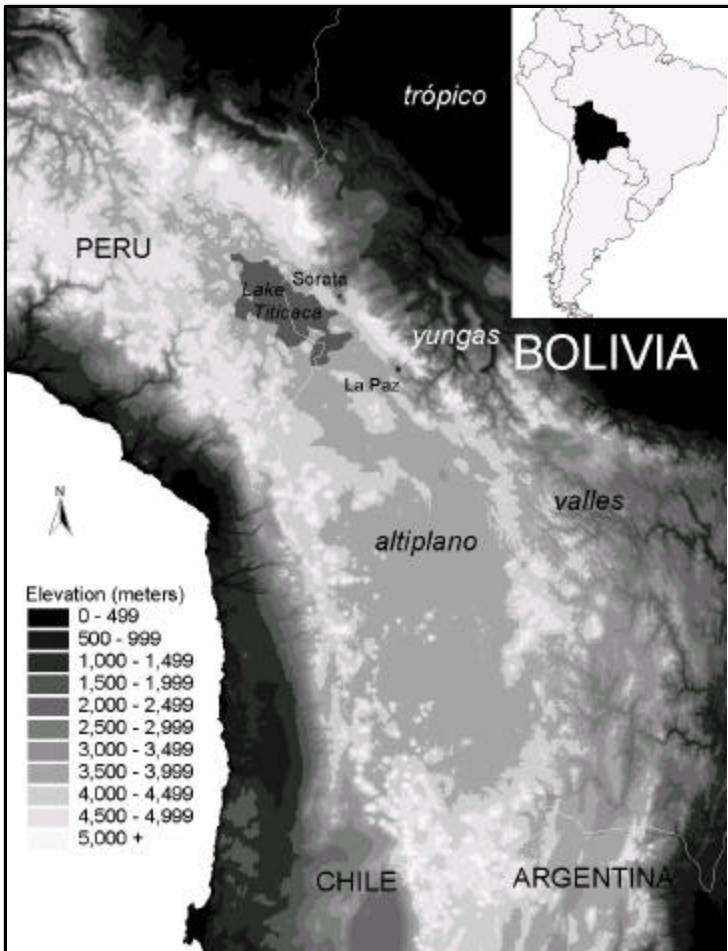


ANDEAN BOLIVIA SUMMER STUDY ABROAD

Second Summer Session 2003: July 7-28



The Andean Bolivia Summer Study Abroad Program introduces students to Andean Geography (GHY 3530) and Globalization and Resistance in Andean Bolivia (GHY 3531) through direct field experience, reading, discussions, and meetings with guest speakers. A high mountain excursion from the town of Sorata provides an outstanding field setting for the study of Andean mountain geography, whereas meetings with guest speakers in La Paz and Cochabamba introduce students to the processes, effects, and resistance movements associated with globalizing forces.

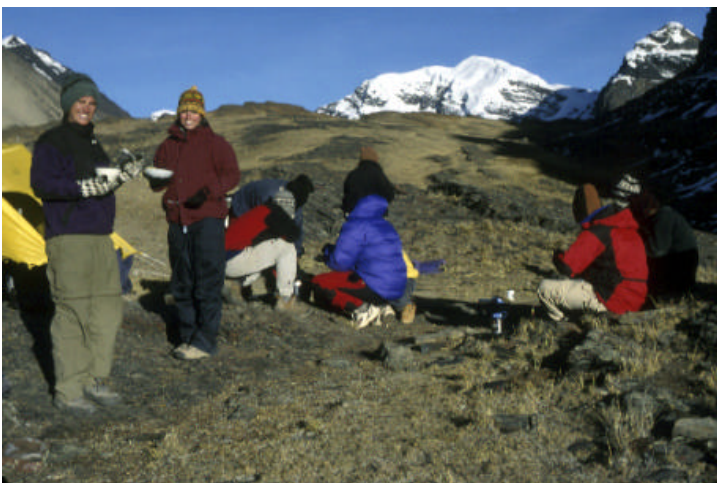
Cost: \$2100 (includes airfare, but not tuition)
